TRAINING OUR COMMUNITY

In support of the programming that is part of ADAMH's plans and goals for the community, ADAMH staff members have been busy since January 1, 2022, holding free trainings for the general public as well as behavioral health professionals in need of continuing education.

Thus far, we've conducted the following trainings: Youth Mental Health First Aid (YMHFA) virtually on February 2; Question, Persuade, and Refer (QPR) for Meals on Wheels on February 16; Prevention Series: The 'Why' of the Strategic Prevention Framework virtually on February 18; QPR for Meals on Wheels on February 28; Peer Recovery Supporter virtually from March 7–11 and 14–18; QPR, including a YMHFA overview and Youth Mental Health and Mobile Crisis presentation, for Liberty Union School District on March 14; Crisis Intervention Teacher Training for Liberty Union-Thurston School District Professional Development Day on March 14; Prevention Series: Prevention Science and the Historical Progression of the Field virtually on March 25; and YMHFA on April 5.

Throughout the rest of state fiscal year 2022, ADAMH will offer the following:

- Prevention Series: Ethics for Ohio's Prevention Professionals – April 29

- Behavioral Addictions: Understanding and Treating the New Addictions of Gambling, Sex, Internet, Gaming, and Spending – May 13
- YMHFA* – June 3
- Peer Recovery Supporter (Virtual)* – June 6–10 and 13–17
