HELPING PARENTS HELP THEIR CHILDREN

Do you want to reduce conflict with your child? Have better relationships with your children? Better support your child in completing schoolwork during remote learning? Help children manage their own behavior?

The Fairfield County Educational Service Center in partnership with the Fairfield County ADAMH Board will be offering PAX Tools training to parents and childcare providers in Fairfield County thanks to Prevention Funding from the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services.

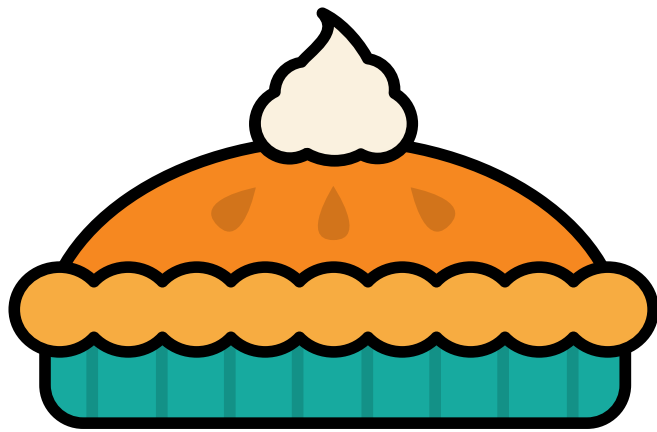
PAX Tools is a collection of evidence-based, trauma-informed strategies to improve cooperation and self-regulation with youth. PAX Tools draws on decades of science to create strategies that support parents, youth workers, and other caring adults to create a nurturing environment that ultimately helps kids thrive.

PAX Tools is intended for any caring adults who interact with children, such as parents, caregivers, professionals, and volunteers. Caregivers who participate in PAX Tools trainings will receive the materials they need to effectively use PAX Tools with children, including the PAX Tools app.
