Fairfield County ADAMH Board requests proposals for new programs

LANCASTER, Ohio, December 8 — The Fairfield County Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health (ADAMH) Board is accepting proposals for new SFY 2023 programs in the four areas of Homeless Outreach and Support, Services to Homebound Senior Citizens, Youth Support and Wellness, and Support Groups. Programs must serve residents of Fairfield County.

“We are excited to receive new and innovative ideas for programming to better serve the Fairfield County community,” says ADAMH Board Executive Director Marcy Fields, LISW-S. “Agencies and other providers must complete and submit the required documents by the deadlines to have their proposals considered.”

Eligible provider agencies have until 5 p.m. on January 19, 2022, to make their submissions. However, they must express their intents to submit proposals via an online form by no later than 5 p.m. on January 12, 2022. Fields highly recommends that all interested parties attend a virtual Q and A session via Zoom from 10 a.m. to noon on December 13, 2021.
